

TOWN OF ARCADIA LAKES
COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 9, 2014

Town Council of Arcadia Lakes met on October 9th at the Town Hall Conference Room At 6:00 PM.

ATTENDING were Mayor Mark Huguley; Mayor Pro tem Don Davis; Council members: Peter Chesney, Linda Jackson, and Rusty Onley. Town Attorney Charles Cook; Town Clerk Christine Murphy; CAT Deputy Chris Mastrianni. Town Residents attending were Peggy Smith; Fred and Alicia Myhrer.

Mayor Huguley opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

DEPUTY REPORT: Burglaries occur more often this time of year with schools back in Session and Holidays kicking off; and usually in the daytime between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Anything suspicious or anyone walking or driving through the area and look suspicious, don't hesitate to call 911 and have them checked out. Cops on Tops of Donut Shops raised \$20,000 recently for Special Olympics. Also, a burglary was reported at 20 Ashworth Lane in the middle of the day, when Jewelry and other valuable items were stolen, Deputy Mastrianni reported.

BREAST CANCER WALK: There will be a walk from Dent Middle School to the Tree of Life October 10th, that Sheriff Lott has assigned deputies, with the help of Forest Acres, to patrol, Deputy Mastrianni reported. Mayor Huguley said that since most of the route is in Arcadia Lakes, he appreciates their help.

SEPTEMBER MINUTES: Mayor Huguley asked if there were corrections or additions to the September minutes. Mr. Cook said that under the paragraph "Roper Pond Update", He would like to see his wording changed from "big win" to "good Opportunity". Mayor Huguley moved that the minutes be accepted with correction; Ms. Jackson seconded the motion, which was approved.

TOWN BEAUTIFICATION: Mr. Chesney reported that he had attended a SC Forestry Commission Seminar at Saluda Shoals Park to learn more about trees, and get an opinion about our tree ordinance. He said he had obtained some quotes from "Grounds Guys" for budgeting purposes. Mr. Walks Milligan, of Grounds Guys presented a Landscape Enhancement Quote to replace Town Entry signs with Brick Signs; Replacement of fences on Trenholm Road; Irrigation Controller and timer for flowers and shrubs to be planted. After discussion, Mr. Chesney said he would present the plan at the budgeting meeting.

TOWN PICNIC: Christine reported that the October 19th Town Picnic plans are all set with The food, music (thanks to Peter Chesney), Clown, tents, tables, chairs, artists, and Book Exchange. Council members said they would come early to help set up.

PARADE PERMIT: Mayor Huguley said the Town has no Ordinance to cover a parade permit. He moved that the request for help for the Breast Cancer Walk be ratified. Councilman Chesney seconded the motion, which was approved.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
