Town Council of Arcadia Lakes met on May 5, 2016 at 6:00 PM in the Town Hall Conference Room

ATTENDING were Mayor Mark Huguley; Mayor Pro Tem Don Davis; Council members: Peter Chesney, Linda Jackson, and Michael Smith. Also attending were Town Attorney, Charles Cook, and Town Clerk Christine Murphy. Town residents attending were Bernie Gaudi, Peggy Smith, and Robert Dozier.

Mayor Huguley opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

DEPUTY'S REPORT: Deputy Givens reported for Deputy Mastrianni, who was out with an injured shoulder. There had been several car break-ins and stolen yard equipment and trailers. He reminded the residents to report anything suspicious, especially someone walking around with a backpack late at night. Always lock your vehicle, and leave valuables out of sight.

APRIL 7 COUNCIL MINUTES:

APRIL 14 SPECIAL MEETING:

Mayor Huguley moved that the minutes be approved for April 7th Council and April 14th Special Meeting; Mr. Davis seconded the motion, which was approved.

LC ORDINANCE AMENDMENT: Mayor Huguley reported that any changes regarding the present LC Zoning Ordinance has to have a public hearing and notice in the paper, and must go to the Planning Commission. Mayor Huguley said that if Mr. Cook is ready with the formatting, council may be able to agree on it and use that document to go with the public notice, which should go out tomorrow. There is a 15 day schedule required on that, Mayor Huguley said. After discussion, Mayor Huguley said he understands that the Notice and Hearing have to fall between first and second reading of the amended ordinance. Mayor Huguley moved that the first reading of the amended LC District Zoning ordinance be approved. Ms. Jackson seconded the motion, which was approved for first reading.

ARCADIA WOODS LAKE DAM: Mr. Gaudi said he would like to see some progress on repairing the road and dam in front of his house on Arcadia Lakes Drive. He said he did not believe that it is an unsafe dam. Discussion followed.
