

TOWN OF ARCADIA LAKES
COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 7, 2019

Town Council of Arcadia Lakes met in the Town Hall Conference Room on February 7, 2019.

ATTENDING was Mayor Mark Huguley; Council members: Peter Chesney, Michael N. Smith and Jim Cullen; Town Attorney, Scott Elliott; Town Clerk Elizabeth Krajewski; Town Residents Larry Funderburk and Zane Padgett.

The February minutes were approved with corrections.

DEPUTY'S REPORT: No new news to report. There were a few traffic stops, but nothing major.

NEW BUSINESS: Mayor Huguley addressed gun fire. The town now has a gun fire log. Mayor Huguley stressed the importance of calling and reporting any gun fire heard so that the Town has record of it.

A motion was made and approved for the use of a drone for baseline survey to assist in monitoring tree removal in proposed development at a cost of \$200.

OLD BUSINESS:

Beautification: The town is still in the process of finding a company. There are currently two company quotes on the table.

TOWN ELECTIONS: Larry Funderburk reported on the Town Election Commission as far as deciding on whether or not to turn it over to the County. No decision was reached with the absence of Mayor Pro Tem Linda Jackson. Council will revisit at the next Council meeting.

Attorney Scott Elliott reported that Mr. Coleman has not sold the property at 6625 Arcadia Lakes Road. Mr. Coleman failed to acknowledge the note sent by the Town Clerk. Attorney Scott Elliott suggested the Town entering the property to clean/make repairs and file a lean to cover the costs of repairs and/or cleaning. Mayor Huguley suggested he call Forest Acres to if Arcadia Lakes could use one of their inspectors to get an estimate of the property.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
