

TOWN OF ARCADIA LAKES  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
DECEMBER 5, 2019

The Town of Arcadia Lakes met in the Town Hall Conference Room on December 5, 2019.

Attending was Mayor Mark Huguley; Mayor Pro Tem Linda Jackson; Council members: Peter Chesney, Jim Cullen, and Mike Smith. Town Clerk Elizabeth Krajewski; Town Attorney Scott Elliott. Building Inspector candidate Chris Netherton.

The minutes were approved with corrections.

DEPUTY REPORT: Deputy Perez reported on several break ins within the town. She expressed the importance to keep all car and house windows and doors locked, to be vigilant of any suspicious activity in the town and to always report it.

NEW BUSINESS:

Building Inspector Proposal: Chris Netherton was present to go over his proposals for becoming the town's new building inspector. Upon hearing his proposals, Mayor Huguley made a motion that the town amend the agenda to include the selection of a building official for the town. Mrs. Jackson seconded the motion, which was approved. Mayor Huguley then made a motion to select Chris Netherton as the towns building official to be compensated on a demand basis on each inspection. Mr. Smith seconded the motion, which was approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

IGA for Municipal Code Enforcement by Deputies Update: Attorney Scott Elliott reported the town is still in negotiations, but progress is being made.

Banners: All banners have been removed and no replacements will be put in their place at this time.

Public Hearing and Adoption of FY 2020 Town Budget: Council considered second reading. Mike Smith made a motion to adopt the FY 2020 town budget. Jim Cullen seconded the motion, which was approved.
